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## Importance of Outdoor Play

Outdoor play gives children the space to move their bodies, explore their environment, and learn through real-life experiences. Running, climbing, digging, and playing outside supports physical development, coordination, confidence, and overall well-being.

You may notice your child coming home with muddy boots or dirty clothes, and we want to reassure families that this is all part of the learning process. Getting messy helps children build problem-solving skills, creativity, and sensory awareness. Puddles, mud, sticks, and melting snow provide rich opportunities for children to ask questions, make predictions, and explore cause and effect.

We view outdoor play as an extension of the classroom—where curiosity leads the learning. As the weather warms, we kindly ask families to continue sending weather-appropriate clothing so children can fully participate and enjoy these valuable outdoor experiences.

## How to Support at Home

### How Families Can Support Outdoor Learning at Home

- Dress for mess! Choose clothes that can get muddy, wet, or sandy—because the best learning often happens in the messiest moments.
- Say yes to puddles. Jumping, splashing, and exploring water builds balance, coordination, and pure joy.
- Let curiosity lead. Take walks and talk about what you see—melting snow, worms, birds, or muddy footprints. Simple questions spark big thinking!
- Slow it down. Children don't need fancy activities—sticks, rocks, leaves, and fresh air are powerful learning tools.
- Celebrate the dirt. A muddy child is a happy, busy learner! A quick change of clothes and a bath later means a day well spent.

Outdoor play doesn't have to be perfect—it just has to be fun. Thank you for supporting your child's learning through exploration, movement, and a little bit of mess!
